



Oh My Stars Scarf

with YouTube Help Video

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Here's a fun stitch that's part flower, part star, and part soft, colorful, puffiness. And I've turned it into a nice neck cowl for myself – but feel free to make it into a longer scarf if you wish. Materials:

1 skein Red Heart Boutique Unforgettable Yarn (270 yds/247 m per skein) in color Candied.

Size H (5 mm) crochet hook.

Yarn needle, Scissors. *Optional: Soft Tape Measure, Button(s).*

Size/Gauge

Finished sample - Width = 6.5" (16.5 cm) Length = 30" (76.2 cm). You can adjust the width of this scarf by starting with more or less "Completed Puffs" - and the length by adding or subtracting rows.



Terminology:

CH = Chain	LP = Loop	SC = Single Crochet	ST = Stitch
YO = Yarn Over			

Instructions:

Completed Puff: Lengthen LP. YO, insert hook into (slipknot for very first puff, SC for remainder puffs), YO and pull through. Pinch bottom STs, YO, pull through all LPs on hook, while still holding left LP. Insert hook into left LP, make SC. CH 1.

3-Puff Cluster: Lengthen LP. YO, insert hook into SC, YO and draw up LP. In next SC, [YO, insert hook, YO and draw up LP] twice. In next SC, [YO, insert hook, YO and draw up LP] twice. Holding left LP, YO, pull through all LPs. SC in left LP. CH 1.

Scarf:

Foundation Row: Loose slipknot. CH 1. Make 8 Completed Puffs.

Row 1: Make 1 Completed Puff (all rows begin with a completed puff). Make 3-Puff Cluster across. Turn.

Row 2: Make 1 Completed Puff. Make 3-Puff Cluster across. Turn. Repeat Row 2 for the desired length.

Finishing: Cut and weave in ends. Sew on optional button(s).
