



Simple Origami Rose (Crochet)

Crochet roses are really nice to make. This one is so very simple to make. If you know how to crochet a plain circle, you can make this rose flower. Check out the how-to video on the Naztazia YouTube channel here:

Terminology:

CH = Chain

DC = Double Crochet

RPT = Repeat

SLST = Slip Stitch

ST= Stitch

Size:

6" circumference x 3.5" H.

Materials:

Small amounts of Red Heart Super Saver (less than 50 yds). Sample used Petal Pink, Perfect Pink and Orchid. G hook (4, 4.25, 4.5 mm). Yarn needle, scissors. Floral stems.

Instructions:

Make a magic ring. CH 3.

RND 1: 11 DC in ring. Pull ring closed. SLST to CH-3.

RND 2: 1 DC in same SP as CH. RPT [2 DC] around. SLST to CH-3.

RND 3: 1 DC in same SP. 1 DC in next ST. RPT [2 DC, 1 DC] around. SLST to CH-3.

RND 4: 1 DC in same SP. 1 DC in next 2 STs. RPT [2 DC, 1 DC, 1 DC] around. Do not SLST. The SP between STs will form a NOTCH. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

FINISH

With right-side up and NOTCH at top, roll circle from the bottom edge to the top. Look for the notch, as that designates the midpoint. Place fingers inside from the bottom, and fold upwards, stopping at the notch. Tuck right side in and bring left side over. The flower should stay as is; however, if needed sew a few stitches to secure. Hot glue flower to existing floral stems.
