



Stitchorama by Naztazia Larksfoot Stitch Pattern (Crochet)

Terminology:

CH = Chain

DC = Double Crochet

RPT = Repeat

SP = Space

ST= Stitch

Instructions:

Multiple of 4+1. Note: Turning CH-3 counts as a DC.

EDC = Extended Double Crochet. Yarn over (YO), insert hook in CH-1 SP 2 rows below, draw up a tall loop, YO, draw through 2 loops, YO, draw through last 2 loops.

CH 29.

ROW 1: DC in 4th CH from hook. DC in next CH. RPT [CH 1, SK 1, 1 DC in next 3 CHs] across until last 4 CHs. CH 1. SK 1, 1 DC in last 3 CHs. CH 3. Turn.

ROW 2: Make 1 DC over every DC and CH 1 over every CH-1. CH 3. Turn.

ROW 3: RPT [CH 1, SK 1, 1 DC, EDC, 1 DC] across until last 2 STs. CH 1, SK 1, 1 DC in last ST. CH 3. Turn.

ROW 4: CH 1 over every CH-1 and DC over every DC and EDC. CH 3. Turn.

ROW 5: EDC. RPT [1 DC, CH 1, SK 1, 1 DC, EDC] across until last ST. In last ST, DC. CH 3. Turn.

ROW 6: DC over every DC and EDC and CH 1 over every CH-1. CH 3. Turn.

ROWS 7+: RPT ROWs 3-6.

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
