



Cake Yarn Scarf (Crochet)

This cake yarn scarf is a pretty and easy to make scarf. It uses one ball, or cake, of Lion Brand's Mandala yarn (DK weight). And it is all single crochet stitches in the back loops. The YouTube video shows some tips and tricks for measuring, counting, checking gauge, sewing, and weaving in ends. Terminology:

CH = Chain	RPT = Repeat	SC = Single Crochet	ST= Stitch
------------	--------------	---------------------	------------

Size:

12" W x 30" L.	Gauge: 12 STS x 14 ROWS = 4"/10.2 cm SQ

Materials:

1 ball or cake of Lion Brand's Mandala yarn. Sample used Sparkle / Draco.

Instructions:

CH 37.

ROW 1: Skip first CH, and SC in back loop of each CH. (Total = 36 SC). CH 1, turn.

ROW 2: 1 SC in back loop of each ST. (Total = 36 SC). CH 1, turn.

ROWS 3-104: 1 SC in back loop of each ST. (Total = 36 SC). CH 1, turn.

ROW 105: 1 SC in back loop of each ST. (Total = 36 SC). Fasten off, leaving a 36" tail end for sewing.

FINISH: Sew the two shorter sides together to form an infinity scarf. Weave in ends.
