Here are some nice and easy baby booties. They look complicated but are not. The shoes are made flat, using just back and forth single crochet. Afterwards, they are sewn into shape. Materials:

1 ball Red Heart Chic Sheep in green and 1 in white. Less than 50 yards total is needed.

Size F 3.75 hook. Scissors. Optional button. Visit <u>http://naztazia.com</u> for supply info.

Size/Gauge

0-6 months, 6-12 months, 12-15 months. Gauge: 8 stitches and 8 rows = 2" sq.

Terminology:

CH = chain	SC = single crochet	ST = stitch
Instructions:

Sizes: 0-6 months (6-12 months, 12-15 months). Make 2 booties.

BACK:

With green, CH 15 (17, 19)

ROW 1: Skip the first CH, and SC across. CH 1, turn.

ROW 2-19: SC across. CH 1, turn.

ROW 20: SC across, until last ST. In last ST, begin SC with green and finish with white yarn. Do not cut yarn. Carry green along the sides. CH 1, turn.

FRONT:

ROW 1: With white, SC in back loops only (from now on) in each of next 8 (10, 12) STs. CH 1, turn.

ROW 2: SC across. In last ST, begin SC with white and finish with green yarn. CH 1, turn. **ROW 3:** With green, SC across. CH 1, turn.

ROW 4: SC across. In last ST, begin SC with green and finish with white yarn. CH 1, turn. **ROW 5-22:** Continue in pattern, alternating 2 rows of white with 2 rows of green yarn.

Fasten off both the green and white yarn, leaving an 18" tail end for sewing.

SEW:

1. Fold the solid green section in half towards the striped section. Fold the striped section in half towards the solid green section. Sew the striped section to the solid green section.

2. Using the white tail end yarn, weave along the top edge of the striped section. Go around twice to secure it. Pull tightly to close top-front of shoe. Make several stitches underneath to secure the yarn. Weave in ends and cut yarn. Fold down back section of shoe.

3. Using the green tail end yarn, weave along the bottom edge of the striped section. Go around twice to secure it. Pull tightly to close bottom-front of shoe. Make several stitches underneath to secure the yarn. Continue using same yarn to sew bottom seam. Weave in ends and cut yarn.

4. Add decorative button if desired. Ensure the button is sewn very securely so baby does not accidently remove it.
