Faux - Fake Broomstick Lace 001 (Crochet)

I love the look of broomstick lace crochet. However, broomstick lace can be somewhat challenging having to hold the large knitting needle and make crochet stitches at the same time. This faux fake broomstick lace stitch is the solution. With this stitch you do not need a knitting needle. You just use your regular crochet hook. You draw up smaller loops and only 4 of them at a time and make your single crochet stitches in the top as you go. Also, a little history - broomstick lace crochet has also been known through the years as Jiffy Lace, Peruvian Lace, Peacock Stitch and a few other names. Terminology:

CH = Chain	SC = Single Crochet	RPT = Repeat	ST= Stitch	YO = Yarn over
------------	---------------------	--------------	------------	----------------

Instructions:

Multiple of 4. Note: Pull up loops approx. $\frac{1}{2}$ " to $\frac{3}{4}$ ". Consistency is the key.

With Color A, CH 36.

ROW 1: Pull up a loop in the next 3 CHs. YO, pull through all 4 loops. CH 1. Make 4 SC in the middle of loops. RPT [Pull up a loop in the next 4 CHs. YO, pull through 4 loops, YO, pull through last 2 loops. Make 3 SC in the middle of loops] across. Fasten off.

ROW 2: With next Color, place a slipknot on your hook and slip stitch to the back loop of the first ST. Pull up a loop in the next 3 STs, back loops only from now on. YO, pull through all 4 loops. CH 1. Make 4 SC in the middle of loops. RPT [Pull up a loop in the next 4 STs. YO, pull through 4 loops, YO, pull through last 2 loops. Make 3 SC in the middle of loops] across. Fasten off.

ROWS 3+: RPT ROW 2, changing colors every row.
