



Sweet Simple Butterfly (Crochet)

This butterfly works great on a hat, scarf, headband, handbag and more. You can make the butterfly in one color, or 2-3 colors. It is made in the round, and then folded in half to form the butterfly shape. Check out the how-to video on the Naztazia YouTube channel here:

Materials:

Small amounts of DK weight [#3] yarn. Sample used Red Heart Baby Hugs Light in 3 colors.

Size G (4.0 mm or 4.25 mm) crochet hook. Sewing yarn needle. Scissors. Optional chenille stick (pipe cleaner) and beads. Visit <http://naztazia.com> for where to purchase supplies.

Size/Gauge

Size: 5" wide by 3.5" tall

Terminology:

CH = Chain	DC = Double Crochet	RPT = Repeat	SC= Single Crochet
SLST = Slip Stitch	SP = Space		

Instructions:

Watch the YouTube tutorial video here: <http://youtube.com/naztazia> Look for "Sweet Simple Butterfly."

With yellow, make a slipknot. CH 6. SLST to the first CH to form ring.

RND 1: CH 3. 2 DC in ring. CH 4. RPT [3 DC in ring, CH 4] 7 times. SLST to top of starting CH.

Cut/weave ends. Total = 8 CH spaces.

RND 2: With green, make a slipknot on hook. SLST in a CH-4 SP. CH 3. In SP, 4 DC, CH 5, 5 DC. RPT [In next SP: 5 DC, CH 5, 5 DC] around. SLST to top of starting CH. Cut/weave ends.

RND 3: With pink, make a slipknot on hook. SLST in a CH-5 SP. CH 3. In SP, 8 DC, CH 2, 9 DC. SC in next SP. RPT [In next SP: 9 DC, CH 2, 9 DC. SC in next SP] around. SLST to top of starting CH.

Cut/weave ends.

Fold work in half (4 petals on one side, 4 on the other). Bend a chenille stick in half and twist it on top to secure it. Or crochet 12 CHs (more or less), wrap around, and tie and knot on top.
