I find chocolate and flowers make life so much better. While I can't help out with the chocolate, I can present to you this free crochet pattern for a pretty Bell Petal Flower. Materials:

Less than 20 yds /18.2 m of Red Heart Super Saver yarn in either 1 or 2 colors.

Crochet Hook – Size G (4.00 or 4.25 mm). Sewing needle (for weaving in ends). Scissors.

Button, gem, bead, or other small decorative item for the center.

Size/Gauge

Finished size: 3.5"/8.9 cm diameter

Terminology:

B/W = Between	CH = Chain	DC = Double Crochet
HDC = Half Double Crochet	RND = Round	RPT = Repeat
SC = Single Crochet	SLST = Slip Stitch	ST = Stitch

Instructions:

Center: With Color A, make a magic ring. CH 1.

RND 1: 7 SC in ring. Pull end to tighten ring. SLT to first ST.

RND 2: CH 5. *DC in next ST, CH 2*. RPT B/W * and * around. SLST to 3rd CH. Cut/weave ends.

Petals: With Color B, SLST on hook. SLST to top of a DC.

Each Bell Petal: *CH 5, SLST to next DC, CH 1. Turn. In ring, 1 SC, 1 HDC, 5 DC. Turn. Working along the side of previous RND's DC, 4 DC. Reach across and SLST to DC*. RPT B/W * and * around for a total of 7 petals.

Finish: Cut, weave in all ends. Add decoration in center if desired
