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Blooming Flower (Crochet)

This flower works great on a hat, scarf, headband, handbag and more. You can make the flower in one color, or 2-3 colors. The flower is made in a long strip and then rolled to form the floral shape. ## Materials:

Small amounts of DK weight [#3] yarn. Sample used Red Heart Baby Hugs in 3 colors per flower. Size G (4.0 mm or 4.25 mm) crochet hook. Sewing yarn needle. Scissors.

## Instructions:

Watch the YouTube tutorial video here: <u>http://youtube.com/naztazia</u> Look for "Crochet Blooming Flower." In the sample pink flower, Color A is yellow. Color B is light pink. Color C is dark pink.

With Color B (light pink), CH 52.

**ROW 1:** HDC in 2<sup>nd</sup> CH from hook. RPT \*CH 1, SK 1 CH, HDC in next CH\* across. Change to Color A (yellow). CH 3, turn.

**ROW 2:** RPT [DC in next CH-1 SP, DC in next HDC] 5 times. DC in next CH-1 SP. HDC in next HDC. Change to Color B (light pink). RPT [In next CH-1 SP: SC, CH 2, 1 DC, CH 2, SC] 8 times. Change to Color C (dark pink). RPT [In next CH-1 SP: SC, CH 3, 2 TR, CH 3, SC] 11 times. Cut/weave in ends.

Cut a 15" piece of Color B (light pink) and thread yarn needle. Roll flower along its ROW 1, starting at the yellow center edge. Turn flower over to the back side and sew across flower to secure. Cut/weave in ends.
