Materials:

4 skeins of Red Heart Super Saver yarn (364 yds/333 m per skein, medium weight yarn). 1 skein in Aran, Spring Green, Pumpkin, Lemon.

Crochet Hook, Size G (4 mm or 4.25 mm) if you crochet loosely - or H (5 mm) if you crochet tighter.

Needle (to weave in ends). Scissors. Tape measure.

Size/Gauge

Finished size: 24"/61 cm circumference by 9"/22.9 cm height

Gauge: 1 granny square = 4"

Granny square (make 6):

With Lemon, slipknot. CH 6. SLST to 1st CH to form ring.

RND 1: CH 3 (counts as 1 DC). 2 DC. CH 2. [3 DC, CH 2] 2 times. 3 DC. HDC to CH 3.

RND 2: With Pumpkin, make a slipknot on hook. 2 DC in corner space. *1 DC across. In corner [2 DC, CH 2, 2 DC]* 3 times. 1 DC across. 2 DC in space. HDC to CH 3.

RND 3: With Spring Green, slipknot on hook. 2 DC in corner space. *1 DC across. In corner [2 DC, CH 2, 2 DC]* 3 times. 1 DC across. 2 DC in space. HDC to CH 3. Leave a long (18") tail end for sewing squares together.

Sew 6 granny squares together in a ring. Cut and weave in all ends. Ring should be 24"/61 cm.

Brim (lower portion):

RND 1: With Aran, slipknot on hook. Working in back loops for this round only, starting at the space in between a square, 1 DC. Mark stitch. 1 DC around, marking all spaces in between squares with a paper clip or stitch marker. SLST to first stitch.

- *increases will occur below along marked stitches* -

RND 2: CH 3. 1 DC in same space. Mark stitch. 1 DC around, except in marked stitches. Marked stitches are 2 DC in same space. Mark first stitch of 2 DC. SLST to first stitch.

RND 3: (optional) Repeat RND 2 if desired.

RND 4: CH 1. Reverse SC around for edging. Cut and weave in ends.

Crown (upper portion):

RND 1: With Aran, slipknot on hook. Working in back loops for this round only, starting at the space in between a square, 1 DC. Mark stitch. 1 DC around, marking all spaces in between squares with a paper clip or stitch marker. SLST to first stitch.

- *decreases will occur below along marked stitches* -

RND 2: CH 3. DC2TOG along next 2 stitches. Mark stitch. 1 DC around, except in marked stitches. Marked stitches begin a DC2TOG. Mark top of DC2TOG. SLST to first stitch.

RNDs 3-7: Repeat RND 2. Cut and weave in all ends.

With a doubled strand yarn (12"-18"), use a yarn needle to weave along the top edge. Pull tightly to close the top. Knot it securely, cut and weave in all ends.
