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This is a crochet version of the traditional ribbon Hana Kanzashi flowers from Japan. The flower is 3D (3 dimensional) but is nice and flat on the back, so it attaches easily to hats, scarves, handbags and more. Check out the how-to video on the Naztazia YouTube channel here:

Materials:

Less than 20 yards of Red Heart Super Saver yarn.

Size F (3.75 mm) crochet hook. Yarn needle. Scissors.

Button (optional).

Finished Size:

3.5"/8.9 cm diameter

Gauge:

Not important.

Terminology:

B/W = Between	CH = Chain	DC = Double Crochet	RND = Round
RPT = Repeat	SLST = Slip stitch	SP = Space	ST = Stitch

Instructions:

Slipknot. CH 5. SLST to form ring.

Rnd 1: CH 5 (counts as 1 DC + CH 2). DC in same SP. CH 2. *In next CH [DC, CH 2, DC, CH 2].* RPT B/W * and * 3 more times. SLST to 3rd CH. Total = 10 DC & 10 SP.

Rnd 2: CH 3 (counts as 1 DC). 4 DC in top SP. 5 DC along DC. 1 DC in ring. 5 DC along DC. * 5 DC in top SP. 5 DC along DC. 1 DC in ring. 5 DC along DC.* RPT B/W * and * around. SLST to close petal.

Finishing: Cut and weave in all ends. Sew on optional button if desired.
