



## Stitchorama by Naztazia

### How to Crochet with Beads

with YouTube Help Video

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Have you wondered how to crochet with beads before? The following video and written pattern will show you how easy it is to add beads to your crochet work. The key to beaded crochet is finding beads with a large enough hole to fit the yarn through. Once you do that, string the beads onto the yarn and begin crocheting. I hope you enjoy this easy-to-do stitch pattern from Stitchorama by Naztazia collection. #### Materials:

50 yards yarn, any weight. For this sample, a chunky/bulky weight yarn was used.

36 pony beads

Size L - 8mm crochet hook, or any size compatible with the yarn.

Yarn needle (for stringing the beads onto the yarn)

#### Terminology:

CH = Chain	SC = Single Crochet	RPT = Repeat	ST= Stitch
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#### Instructions:

Using the yarn needle, string all 36 beads onto one end of the yarn ball or skein. Push the beads several feet from the end of the yarn. Remove the yarn needle. With the crochet hook, CH 13.

ROW 1: SC in 2<sup>nd</sup> CH from hook and in each CH across. Total = 12 SC.

ROW 2: CH 1, turn. Slide 1 bead towards hook. Keeping bead at back of work, SC. RPT [Slide next bead towards hook. Keeping bead at back of work, SC] across. Total = 12 beaded SC.

ROW 3: CH 1. turn. SC in each ST across.

ROW 4: RPT ROW 2.

ROW 5: RPT ROW 3.

RPT ROWs 4 & 5 for desired height.
