



Flowing Flower (Crochet)

Materials:

Less than 20 yards of Red Heart Super Saver yarn (364 yds/333 m per skein, medium weight yarn) in Color A and Color B. Pink flower sample uses Aran (A) for center and Perfect Pink (B) for petals.

Crochet Hook, Size G (4 mm or 4.25 mm)

Needle (to weave in ends). Scissors.

Button – optional for center.

Size/Gauge

Finished size: 4" (10.2 cm) diameter

Terminology:

B/W = Between	CH = Chain	DC = Double Crochet	RND = Round
RPT = Repeat	SC = Single Crochet	SLST = Slip Stitch	ST = Stitch

Instructions:

Center:

With Color A (Aran), slipknot. CH 6. SLST to 1st CH.

RND 1: CH 1. 12 SC in ring. SLST to 1st SC. Cut and weave in ends.

Petals:

With Color B (Perfect Pink), make slipknot on hook. SLST to any ST on Center.

Petal #1: CH 3. DC in next ST. CH 3. 5 DC along side of DC. SLST to bottom of DC.

Petals #2-#12: RPT Petal #1.

Finishing:

Once all 12 petals are completed, CH 3. Turn flower over. SLST in adjacent petal's CH-3 space.
CH 3. SLST in next petal's CH-3 space. RPT B/W * and * around. At the end, SLST to initial CH-3. Cut and weave in all ends.

Sew or glue on a button in the center if desired.
