



My Sweet Angel (Crochet)

Angels are very sweet. Some believe they are all around us protecting us. Sometimes they remind us of a loved one who is no longer here. Make one today in blue, pink, or some other color to remind you of your sweet angel. Materials:

1 ball Aunt Lydia's Crochet Thread, Size 3, in white.

Crochet Hook, Size D (3.25 mm). Needle (to weave in ends). Scissors.

1 yd./0.9 m of 7/8"/2.2 cm white decorative ribbon for wings.

.5 yd./0.45 m of 3/16"/4.8 mm pink or blue picot-trimmed decorative ribbon

1"/2.54 cm faux pearl bead for head. Glue-on heart gem. Hot glue gun. Starch/Stiffening product.

Size/Gauge

Finished size: 5"/12.7 cm width by 6"/15.2 cm height

Gauge: 8 ST x 4 rows = 2"/5.1 cm in Double Crochet.

Slipknot. CH 6. SLST to 1st CH to form ring.

RND 1: CH 3 (counts as 1 DC). 2 DC. CH 2. [3 DC, CH 2] 2 times. 3 DC. HDC to CH 3.

RND 2: CH 3. 1 DC in space. *1 DC across. In corner [2 DC, CH 2, 2 DC]* 3 times. 1 DC across. 2 DC in space. HDC to CH 3.

RNDs 3 & 4: RPT RND 2.

RND 5: CH 1. SC. [Reverse single crochet, CH 1] around.

Cut and weave in ends. Block and/or stiffen with starch, a commercial stiffening product, or half-and-half glue/water mixture. Let dry. Cut white wing ribbon into four 8"/20.3 cm strips. Fold each ribbon into loops and hot glue together. Fold square to form arms. Hot glue loops, pearl (head), and decorative bow with gem to square. Glue or tie an optional ribbon to the top to hang angel.
