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Splendid Shawl (Crochet)

Materials:

2 skeins of Red Heart Ombre (each skein is 482 yds / 440 m). Sample color is Scuba.

Size H (5 mm) crochet hook. Sewing needle (weaving in ends). Scissors.

Size/Gauge

60''/152.4 cm wide by 30''/76.2 cm length. Gauge: 4 clusters (sideways) = 4''/10.16 cm sq.

Terminology:

B/W = Between	CH = Chain	CONT = Continue	DC = Double Crochet
LP = Loop	PREV = Previous	RPT = Repeat	SC = Single Crochet
SK = Skip	SLST = Slip Stitch	SP = Space	TR = Treble Crochet

Instructions:

PICOT = CH 3, SLST in third CH from hook.

FAN = 1 TR. [PICOT, 1 TR] 4 times. (5 TR with 1 PICOT in B/W each TR)

PT FAN = 1 TR. [PICOT, 1 TR] 6 times. (7 TR with 1 PICOT in B/W each TR)

Main Shawl:

Row 1: CH 7. TR in 5th CH from hook. TR in next 2 CHs. Turn.

Row 2: CH 7. TR in 5th CH from hook. TR in next 2 CHs. [SLST into CH-4 SP. CH 4. 3 TR in same SP.] 1 time. Turn.

Row 3: CH 7. TR in 5th CH from hook. TR in next 2 CHs. [SLST into CH-4 SP. CH 4. 3 TR in same SP.] 2 times. Turn.

Row 4: CH 7. TR in 5th CH from hook. TR in next 2 CHs. [SLST into CH-4 SP. CH 4. 3 TR in same SP.] 3 times. Turn.

Continue Row 4 in pattern, increasing the section in brackets [] 1 more time each row. End at Row 37 – or – any multiple of 3 plus 1 if you wish to include the border. If including border, do not fasten off, and proceed to the next section. If omitting border, fasten off and weave in all ends.

Border:

Working along the two outer sides of the shawl (not along top neck edge) –

Row 1: CH 6. DC in SP at bottom of PREV TR. CH 3. SK 3 TR and DC in SP. CH 3. DC at bottom of PREV TR. CONT in pattern until right before cluster at bottom point. CH 3, DC at tip, CH 3, DC in same SP. (3 loops formed at tip). CH 3, SK 3 TR and DC in SP. Proceed to CH-3/DC as before along second side, ending with a DC on top of turning CH. Total number of loops should be divisible by 3. Turn.

Row 2: CH 1. SC in first DC. RPT [CH 5. SC in next DC] across row, ending with SC on top of turning CH. Turn work.

Row 3: CH 4. SC in first LP. RPT [In next LP, FAN. In next LP, (SC, CH 2). In next loop, SC.] along Side #1 and along Side #2 – except at bottom point/tip: make PT FAN instead of FAN. End with SC in last LP. Once completed, cut and weave in all ends.

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
