Materials:

30 yards DK weight yarn in 1 or 2 colors. Sample is Loops & Threads Snuggly Wuggly.

Size F (3.75 mm) crochet hook. Sewing needle. Optional button. Scissors.

3"/7.62 cm diameter

Terminology:

B/W = Between	CH = Chain	DTR = Double Treble	HDC = Half Double Crochet
RND = Round	RPT = Repeat	SC = Single Crochet	SLST = Slip Stitch
SP = Space	TR = Treble Crochet	YO = Yarn over

With Color A, magic ring.

RND 1: CH 5. [1 HDC, CH 3] 4 times. SLST to 2nd CH.

RND 1: CH 1. In each CH-SP, [1 SC, CH 2, 7 TR, CH 2, 1 SC]. Cut, weave in ends.

With Color B, make a slipknot on hook.

RND 3: [From the back, insert hook B/W 2 SCs, then in CH-SP, YO and make 1 SC. CH 5.] 5 times around. SLST to 1st SC.

RND 4: In each CH-SP, [1 SC, CH 3. 11 DTR, CH 3. 1 SC]. Cut, weave in ends.

Add center button if desired.
