



Yarn Wrapped Wreath

Here's a fun and quick project for adults, teens or children. Wrap some thick yarn around a straw wreath, add some flowers, and you are done! Materials:

1 skein Red Heart Irresistible yarn – color of Oatmeal.

1 skein each of Red Heart Super Saver Yarn in Petal Pink, Turqua, DK Orchid (for flowers).

One 18-inch straw wreath.

7 crochet flowers using Naztazia flower patterns: 2 Kanzashi Flowers (pink), 2 Flowing Flowers (purple), 3 Bell Petal Flowers (turquoise).

Few stems of flower sprays (or wheat).

Scissors.

Ribbon to hang wreath (optional).

Size:

18" in diameter (without the sprays/ribbon).

Instructions:

Prepare crocheted flowers. Patterns for Kanzashi Flower (pink), Flowing Flower (purple), Bell Petal Flower (turquoise) are on naztazia.com

Hot glue one end of the yarn to the back of the wreath. Wrap yarn around entire wreath. Cut yarn and glue the final yarn's end in the back. Trim flower sprays or wheat and glue them onto the front of the wreath. Glue crochet flowers to the front of the wreath. Add ribbon to hang wreath.
