CH 33 or multiple of $6+3$

Row 1: SC in $2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{CH}$ and in each CH across. Mark every $6^{\text {th }} \mathrm{SC}$, starting with SC \#2. e.g. mark SC \#2, SC \#8, SC \#14, etc. Turn.

Row 2: CH 3 (counts as $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{DC}$ ). DC across. Turn.
Row 3: CH 1. SC in first ST and in next 2 STs. FPTC around SC \#2 of Row 1. (Note: the video shows optimal stitch placement). FPTC around SC \#7. (Note: SK the ST directly behind each FPTC, now and throughout. At this time, SK the 2 STs). SC in next 4 STs. FPTC around SC \#8. FPTC around SC \#13. SC in next 4 STs. FPTC around SC \#14. FPTC around SC \#19. SC in next 4 STs. CONT in PATT across row, ending with 1 SC in last 3 STs. Turn.

Row 4: RPT Row 2.

Row 5: CH 1. SC in first ST. FPTC around $1^{\text {st }}$ FPTC from Row 3. Note: video shows optimal stitch placement. SC in next 4 STs. FPTC around next FPTC. FPTC around next FPTC. SC in next 4 STs. CONT in PATT across row, ending with 1 SC in last ST. Turn.

Row 6: RPT Row 2.

Row 7: CH 1. 1 SC in first ST and in next 2 STs. FPTC around FPTC. FPTC around next FPTC. SC in next 4 STs. CONT in PATT across row, ending with 1 SC in last 3 STs. Turn.

Row 8: RPT Row 2.

Row 9: RPT Row 5.

Row 10: RPT Row 2.

Row 11: RPT Row 7.

CONT in PATT until desired height.

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
