



Decorate Flip Flops with Ruffle, Eyelash, Pom-pom Yarn & Beads with YouTube Help Video

Pink Flip-Flops

Materials: 1 skein ruffle yarn, 2 skeins embroidery floss (use full floss - do not separate the strands) in a corresponding color, 2 large yellow buttons, 2 small pink buttons, other supplies as listed to the left.

Knot embroidery floss to both the ruffle yarn and flip-flop strap. With the floss, single crochet through the lowest holes of the ruffle yarn and around the strap. Continue around. Hot glue the ends in place. Knot button in place with floss then secure with hot glue. See video on <http://youtube.com/naztazia> for step-by-step instructions.

Yellow Flip-Flops

Materials: 2 skeins embroidery floss (use full floss - do not separate the strands) for the flip-flops, 2 skeins embroidery floss for the bow (more skeins if you want color changes) 2 small yellow buttons, other supplies as listed to the left.

Knot embroidery floss to the flip-flop strap. With the floss, single crochet around the strap. Continue around. Hot glue the ends in place. See video <http://youtube.com/naztazia> for step-by-step instructions.

Bow (make 2 bows): Make a slipknot. Chain 16.

Row 1: Half-double crochet in 3rd chain from hook and then HDC in each stitch across. At the end of the row, chain 2 and turn your work. Do not count the chain 2 as a stitch.

Row 2: Half-double crochet in each stitch across. At the end of the row, chain 2 and turn your work. Do not count the chain 2 as a stitch.

Rows 3-6: Repeat Row 2.

Cut yarn, weave in ends. Thread 8" piece of floss through button. Tie around the center of the crochet bow and knot tightly. Tie and knot this bow to your flip-flop and hot-glue securely.

Green Flip-Flops

Materials: 1 skein fun fur eyelash yarn, 2 large green buttons, 2 small blue buttons, other supplies as listed to the left.

Knot fur yarn to flip-flop strap. Single crochet around the strap. Hot glue the ends in place.

Knot button in place with 8" piece of floss then secure with hot glue. See video

Materials:

All estimates are based upon a size 8 flip-flop (medium). Adjust up or down accordingly.

For all flip-flops:

- A pair of flip-flops
- Scissors
- Hot glue gun with 1-2 glue sticks (low or high-temp guns are both fine)
- Needle for weaving in ends
- Size F crochet hook
- Assortment of buttons for decoration

See each section to the right for specific yarn/thread requirements

Terms:

- **SC** = Single crochet stitch
- **HDC** = Half-double crochet
- **CH** = Chain

American English Crochet Terms

Blue Flip-Flops

Materials: 2 skeins embroidery floss (use full floss - do not separate the strands), approximately 24 lightweight beads for 1 flip-flop (48 for both), 2 large blue buttons, 2 small yellow buttons, 1 beading needle, other supplies as listed above.

With the beading needle, string on 24 beads onto the floss. Knot embroidery floss to flip-flop strap. Do 1 single crochet around the strap. Push 1 bead down to the strap, and chain 1. Do 1 single crochet around strap. Push next bead down to strap, and chain 1. Continue around. Hot glue the ends in place. Knot buttons in place with floss then secure with hot glue. Purple Flip-Flops

Materials: 1 skein pom-pom yarn, 2 skeins embroidery floss (use full floss - do not separate the strands) in a corresponding color, 2 large purple buttons, 2 small lilac buttons, other supplies as listed above.

Knot embroidery floss to the flip-flop strap. With the floss, do 1 single crochet around the strap. Place pom-pom yarn in front of strap, and with the floss, single crochet around both the string part of the pom-pom yarn and the flip-flop strap. Continue around. Hot glue the ends in place. Knot button in place with floss then secure with hot glue. See video <http://youtube.com/naztazia> for step-by-step instructions.
