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<u> Materials:</u>

- 250-300 yards worsted weight yarn used in the scarf shown. However you can use any weight yarn.
- Hairpin Lace Loom if you don't have one, check out the video for an idea of how to make your own. Set the loom for about 2.5" between prongs.
- Size H (5mm) crochet hook or equivalent hook for your size of yarn.
- Scissors

- CH = Chain
- SC = Single Crochet

- 1. Watch my 8-minute video on YouTube. Hairpin lace is difficult to explain in writing ☺
- 2. Make a slipknot. Insert loop on hairpin loom.
- 3. Wrap yarn around other prong, then chain one in slipknot loop.
- 4. Wrap yarn around other prong, then single crochet in next loop.
- 5. Wrap yarn around other prong and repeat around, making 1 single crochet in each loop.
- 6. Make 150-200 loops on each prong. This means 150 loops on the right prong and 150 loops on the left prong, for a grand total of 300 loops.
- 7. Make 4 or 5 hairpin strips. You can make more or less strips if desired.
- 8. Join loops.
- 9. Add fringe/tassel at the edge to conceal ends.
