



Wheel Flower (Crochet)

with YouTube Help Video

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Here is a fun crochet flower that looks good on a hat, headband, shawl, bag, and more. Each petal is made separately and joined in the center ring. Stitches used include the reverse single crochet as well as single crochet, half double crochet, double crochet, and treble crochet. Terminology:

Size/Gauge:

4.75 inch diameter

Materials:

Less than 30 yards of worsted weight yarn. Sample used Red Heart Super Saver. Size H-5 mm hook. Stitch marker. Yarn needle. Scissors. Optional button or gem.

Instructions:

CH 12. SLST into 6th CH from hook.

Petal 1:

Over next 6 CHs: 1 SC (mark back loop), 1 HDC, 2 HDC, 1 DC, 2 DC, 1 TR.
CH 1. Reverse SC in each ST using front loops only. SLST into ring.

Petal 2:

Over the next 6 STs, back loops only: 1 SC (mark back loop), 1 HDC, 2 HDC, 1 DC, 2 DC, 1 TR. Leave remaining STs unworked. CH 1. Reverse SC in each ST using front loops only.

Petals 3-10:

RPT Petal 2.

Finish:

Fasten off, leaving a long tail end for sewing. Sew first petal and last petal together. Weave in all ends. Sew or glue on a button or gem to the middle.
