This is a nice shell stitch made with Tunisian crochet. It is a relatively simple pattern if you already know how to do basic Tunisian stitches. This works great for blankets, scarves, shawls, and more.

Materials:

Worsted weight yarn in several colors, or just one color. I 5.5 mm Tunisian hook (sometimes called an afghan hook). Yarn needle. Scissors.
