



3D Crochet Stitch

with YouTube Help Video

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Here's a fun 3D crochet stitch that is very cool looking. The effect is created by front post double crochet stitches along with double crochet together stitches. This stitch works great for when you need an interesting texture in your project. This looks nice with worsted weight yarn for blankets. Or use a thinner yarn for scarves, hats, shawls and more. Terminology:

CH = Chain	DC = Double Crochet	RPT = Repeat
SC = Single Crochet	SK = Skip/Miss	SLST = Slip Stitch
SP = Space	ST= Stitch	

FPDC5TOG = Front Post Double Crochet 5 Together

FPDC10TOG = Front Post Double Crochet 10 Together

Instructions:

CH 42 or multiple of 8+2.

ROW 1: SC in 2nd CH from hook. RPT [CH 3, SK 3, 1 SC in next ST] across. CH 3, turn.

ROW 2: 5 DC in each CH-3 across. DC in last SC. CH 1, turn.

ROW 3: SC in DC. RPT [CH 3, FPDC10TOG, CH 3, SC in SP] across. CH 3, turn.

ROW 4: 5 DC in each CH-3 across. DC in last SC. CH 1, turn.

ROW 5: SC in DC. FPDC5TOG. CH 3. SC in SP. RPT [CH 3, DC10TOG, CH 3, SC in SP] across until last 5 DC. CH 3. In last 5 DC, FPDC5TOG. SC in top of CH-3. CH 3, turn.

ROWS 6+: RPT ROWS 2-5.
