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Jacob's Ladder (Crochet)

Here's a neat looking stitch pattern. It looks like braids, doesn't it? It is made with chain loops that are then weaved upwards. There's almost a cable look to it too. For this, I'm using just double crochet stitches, single crochet stitches, slip stitches, and chains. It's relatively easy enough for a beginner who already knows those stitches. For the sample I'm changing colors every two rows. But this also looks nice as one solid color as well. Or perhaps maybe alternating with just two colors. However you choose to do it, I think you will like this one! Terminology:

CH = Chain	DC = Double Crochet	RPT = Repeat
SC = Single Crochet	SK = Skip	SLST = Slip Stitch
ST= Stitch

Chain 37. Multiple of 5+2

ROW 1: DC in 4th CH from the hook. DC in each CH across. Turn. Total = 35 DC.

ROW 2: CH 1. SC in each ST. Turn. Total = 35 SC.

ROW 3: CH 3 (counts as 1 DC). 1 DC in in next 4 STs. CH 10. SLST on top of lastmade DC. RPT [1 DC in next 5 STs. CH 10. SLST on top of last-made DC] across until last 5 STs. 1 DC in last 5 STs. Turn. Total = 35 DC.

ROW 4: CH 1. 1 SC in each ST across, pushing the CH-10 loops towards the back. It is helpful to look at the previous DC's for where to place the SCs. Turn. Total = 35 SC.

Continue repeating ROWs 3 & 4, ending on a ROW 4.

Before proceeding, connect loops upwards using the chaining method.

NEXT ROW: CH 3. Make 1 DC in each ST across. Turn. Total = 35 DC.

NEXT TO LAST ROW: CH 1. SC across, counting in groups of 5. On SC # 5, catch the CH loop from below to secure it. On SC #1, go under same CH loop. On the next SC #5, go under next CH loop. On the next SC #1, go under same CH loop. Continue across. Turn. Total = 35 SC.

LAST ROW: CH 3. DC across. Fasten off and weave in all ends.
