SC = Single Crochet	SK = Skip	ST= Stitch

CH 37 (multiple of 6+1)

ROW 1: Make 3 DC in 4th CH from hook. RPT [SK 2 CHs. 1 SC in next CH. SK 2 CHs. 5 DC in next CH] across. At the end, SK 2 CHs, 1 SC in last CH. CH 3, turn.

ROW 2: Make 3 DC in first SC. RPT [1 SC in 3rd DC, 5 DC in SC] across. At the end, make 1 SC in top of CH-3. CH 3, turn.

ROWS 3+: RPT ROW 2.
