Here's a fun wavy stitch that is comprised of chains, slip stitches, and half double crochet. Works great for a scarf, shawl, blanket and more. Terminology:

CH = Chain	HDC = Half Double Crochet	RPT = Repeat
SLST = Slip Stitch	SP = Space	ST = Stitch

Instructions:

Multiple of 10+6. Work in the Back Loops Only throughout. CH 46 for a sample.

ROW 1: SLST in 2nd CH, and in next 4 CHs. RPT [HDC in next 5 CHs, SLST in next 5 CHs] across. Turn.

ROW 2: SLST in first 5 STs. RPT [HDC in next 5 STs, SLST in next 5 STs] across. CH 2. Turn.

ROW 3: (CH-2 always counts as 1st ST). HDC in next 4 STs. RPT [SLST in next 5 STs, HDC in next 5 STs] across. CH 2. Turn.

ROW 4: HDC in next 4 STs. RPT [SLST in next 5 STs, HDC in next 5 STs] across. Turn.

ROW 5: SLST in first 5 STs. RPT [HDC in next 5 STs, SLST in next 5 STs] across.

RPT ROWs 2-5 until desired height is reached.
