



## Stitchorama™ by Naztazia® Bullion Stitch Border (Crochet)

The bullion stitch border is a fun edging for a blanket, shawl, scarf, and more. It is made with a modified bullion stitch done around a chain. ### Terminology:

CH = Chain

RPT = Repeat

SLST = Slip Stitch

ST = Stitch

YO = Yarn over

### Instructions:

Watch the YouTube tutorial video here: <https://youtube.com/naztazia> Look for “Bullion Stitch Border.”

For a single straight edge, the stitch multiple is 3 + 1. As a sample, use an edge containing 40 stitches. Connect the border yarn to one side.

### SHELL

CH 4.

RPT [Place hook underneath CH-4. YO. Pull yarn underneath the CH and towards the front. YO. Remove one loop.] 8 times.

YO, pull through all 9 loops on hook.

Skip 2 STs.

SLST into next ST.

RPT SHELL across row.

At the end, fasten off and weave in ends.
