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Ear Warmer Headband (Crochet)

with YouTube Help Video

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If you are looking for a nice, textured ear warmer headband, this pattern is for you. It can be worn with the gather in the middle or as a straight band. The texture is created by alternating front post double crochet with regular double crochet stitches. Three sizes are included in the pattern, but it is very easy to customize to fit any head size. 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CH = Chain		DC = Double Crochet

Gauge:

12 STs & 8 RNDs = 4''/10.16 cm SQ.

Size:

1-3 year old (16"/3" – 40.64 cm/7.62 cm)	4-12 year old (19"/3.5" – 48.26 cm/8.89 cm)
Teen/Adult (22"/4" - 55.88 cm/10.16 cm)	This pattern is also customizable.

Materials:

1 skein Red Heart Heat Wave (medium weight, 3.5 oz/100 g, 198 yds/181 m per skein) in the color Passport. Size H hook. Sewing needle. Scissors. Measuring tape.

Instructions:

Different sizes are listed in parenthesis. (1-3 year old, 4-12 year old, Teen/Adult)

Note: the initial CH-3 to start an FDC and subsequent CH-3s do NOT count as a ST in this pattern.

RND 1: Leave an 8" starting length of yarn, CH 3. Begin FDC. Make (48, 58, 66).

Measure length. Slightly stretched, strip should be (16", 19", 22"). If it is not, use a different hook size or add/subtract to produce any even number of stitches (divisible by 2). If you need a different size than what is listed above, crochet the length needed with an even number of stitches.

Ensure the strip is not twisted and SLST to the top of the CH-3. The bottom gap will be sewn later.

RND 2: CH 3 (not a ST). RPT [FPDC, DC] around. SLST to top of CH-3.

RND 3: CH 3 (not a ST). RPT [DC, FPDC] around. SLST to top of CH-3.

Alternate RNDs 2 and 3 for a total of (6, 7, 8) RNDs.

Fasten off, leaving a 15" tail end.

With the 8" beginning tail end, sew the gap created on RND 1.

With the 15" tail end, weave in and out along the vertical CH-3s to cinch the center together. Tie and knot securely.

Weave in all ends.
