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Puff Flower (Crochet)

with YouTube Help Video

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These crochet puff flowers are cute and quick to make. They attach nicely to a hat, scarf, shawl, bag and more. Each puff flower requires a small amount of worsted weight yarn, so it's a great scrap yarn project. Check out the how-to video on the Naztazia YouTube channel here:

Terminology:	
CH = Chain	RND = Round
RPT = Repeat	SC = Single Crochet
SLST = Slip Stitch	ST = Stitch
YO = Yarn Over	

PUFF = Complete 3 times: [(YO, insert hook in ST, YO, draw up loop) twice. YO, draw through all loops on hook.] Remove hook. Insert into first ST, grab loop and pull through.

Size/Gauge:

3" diameter. Gauge is not important.

Materials:

Less than 20 yards of worsted weight yarn. Sample used mill ends labeled "Festival: Mixed Fibers." Size H 5 mm hook. Yarn needle. Scissors. Button or gem for the center.

Magic ring

RND 1: CH 1. 8 SC in ring. SLST to 1st ST.

RND 2: RPT [CH 5, SLST in next ST] around. (8 loops)

RND 3: CH 1. From the back, RPT [SC, CH 2] around in each SC. SLST to 1st ST. (8 CH-2 rings)

RND 4: CH 1. In each CH-2, make [1 SC, CH 2, 1 SC]. SLST to 1st ST. (8 CH-2 rings)

RND 5: In each CH-2, make [CH 2, PUFF, CH 2. Then SLST into adjacent SC]. (8 petals)

Fasten off, weave in ends. Glue or sew gem or button to the center.
