



Open Shell Stitch (Crochet)

with YouTube Help Video

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Here's a neat open shell stitch pattern that has two alternating shell stitches within it. This shell stitch works nice for a scarf or a blanket. It can also work nicely for any other item as well. The first row is a little bit tricky to set up. However, all other rows simply repeat row 2, so the stitch pattern becomes very simple after that. Terminology:

CH = Chain	DC = Double Crochet
RPT = Repeat	SC = Single Crochet
SK = Skip	SLST = Slip Stitch
SP = Space	ST = Stitch

CH 38 (multiple of 12+2)

ROW 1: SC in 2nd CH from hook. RPT [SK 2 CHs, in next CH (3 DC, CH 1, 3 DC), SK 2 CHs, SC in next CH, SK 2 CHs, in next CH (1 DC, CH 3, 1 DC), SK 2 CHs, SC in next CH] across. CH 3, turn.

ROW 2: RPT [In next CH-3 SP, (3DC, CH 1, 3 DC). In next CH-1 SP, (1 DC, CH 3, 1 DC)] across. 1 DC in turning CH-3. CH 3, turn.

RPT ROW 2.
