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Snowflake Christmas Ornament (Crochet)

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A crochet snowflake ornament is so much fun to make for Christmas or the winter season! This one is easy to crochet with worsted weight 100% cotton. So, it works up very quickly! Terminology:	
CH = Chain	HDC = Half Double Crochet
RPT = Repeat	SC = Single Crochet
SLST = Slip Stitch	ST = Stitch
2-DC CL = 2 Double Crochet Cluster	2-TR CL = 2 Treble Crochet Cluster
3-TR = 3 Treble Crochet Cluster	

Materials:

15 yards of 100% cotton worsted weight yarn. Sample used Lion Brand Re Up in Sky. Size G - 4 or 4.25 mm crochet hook. Yarn needle. Scissors.

Size/Gauge:

Finished snowflake is 5"x 5". Gauge is not important.

Instructions

Slipknot. CH 6. SLST to form a ring.

RND 1: RPT [CH 4, 2-TR CL, CH 4, SLST in ring] 5 times. For 6th branch, CH 4, 3-TR CL. CH 1. SC in front loop of ST just made (inserting hook from middle of ST then outwards towards the front). **RND 2:** *CH 3, 2-DC CL in front loop of SC. CH 1, SC in front loop of 2-DC CL. RPT [CH 2, HDC, CH 2, SLST in front loop] 3 times. CH 3, 2-DC CL in same front loop. SC on top of next 2-TR CL.* RPT between * and * to complete 6 sides. On the final side, replace the last SC with a SLST to first SC.

Fasten off, weave in ends. If desired, use a 50% glue and 50% water mixture to stiffen snowflake.
