



## Flower Border Edging (Crochet)

### Terminology:

CH = Chain

DC = Double Crochet

RPT = Repeat

SLST = Slip Stitch

ST= Stitch

### Instructions:

Watch the YouTube tutorial video here: <https://youtube.com/naztazia> Look for "Crochet Flower Border Edging."

Stitch multiple of 5 + 4. Begin with CH 3 (counts as 1 DC). Make 1 DC in each of the next 3 STs. 2 DC in the next ST.

**Flower:** Using the 2 DC as a "stitch ring," RPT [CH 2, 1 DC in ring, CH 2, SLST in ring] twice on the first DC. Rotate and RPT [CH 2, 1 DC in ring, CH 2, SLST in ring] twice on the second DC. Facing work in the normal position, CH 2, 1 DC in ring, CH 2, SLST in ring. CH 1 (tightly). 1 DC in each of the next 4 STs.

RPT **Flower** across the row.

If using border around a blanket, place 2 DC in each corner and make a flower in each corner. Fasten off and weave in ends.
