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Towel Topper with Hidden Ring (Crochet)

The crochet towel toppers with hidden ring pattern makes for a nice kitchen accessory. You can easily remove the kitchen towel to wash it because of the hidden ring underneath the topper part. Everything is constructed in one piece starting from the hanging part all the way down to the shell border. These also do very well for craft fairs and bazaars! Terminology:

CH = Chain	DC = Double Crochet	RPT = Repeat
SC = Single Crochet	SLST = Slip Stitch	ST= Stitch
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Size/Gauge:

Buttoned: 8" H x 5" W (at its widest point). 14 STs & 15 rows = 4" SQ.

Materials:

Less than 30 yards of worsted weight yarn. Sample used Red Heart Super Saver in Petal Pink. Size H 5 mm crochet hook. 1.5 inch button. Kitchen towel.

HANGING LOOP:

CH 8.

ROW 1: Skip the first CH, and SC in each CH across. CH 1, turn. Total = 7 SC. **ROWs 2-4:** SC in each ST across. CH 1, turn.

BUTTONHOLE:

ROW 5: SC in the first 3 STs. CH 3. Skip 1 ST. SC in the last 3 STs. CH 1, turn. **ROW 6:** SC in the first 3 STs. SC in CH-3. SC in the last 3 STs. CH 1, turn. Total = 7 SC.

CONTINUE:

ROWs 7-31: SC in each ST across. CH 1, turn.

HIDDEN RING:

ROW 32: SC in each ST across. CH 15. Turn, and SLST into first ST. Turn, and make 15 SC in ring. Turn slightly and make a SLST into the front loop of the closest SC from ROW 31. Continue to TOPPER.

TOPPER:

RND 1:

<u>SIDE A</u>: CH 3. Switching to rounds, and working in front loops, DC in same space. DC in next 2 STs. 2 DC in next ST. DC in next 2 STs. 2 DC in last ST.

<u>SIDE B:</u> Continue working in rounds and in remaining loops, push the hidden ring inward, 2 DC in first ST, DC in next 2 STs, 2 DC in next ST, DC in next 2 STs, 2 DC in last ST. SLST to top of CH-3. **RND 2:** CH 3. (Back to BOTH loops) DC in same space as CH-3. DC in next 3 STs. RPT [2 DC in next

ST, DC in next 3 STs] around. SLST to top of CH-3.

RND 3: CH 3. DC in same space as CH-3. DC in next 4 STs. RPT [2 DC in next ST, DC in next 4 STs] around. SLST to top of CH-3.

RND 4: CH 3. DC in same space as CH-3. DC in next 5 STs. RPT [2 DC in next ST, DC in next 5 STs] around. SLST to top of CH-3.

RND 5: CH 3. DC in same space as CH-3. DC in next 6 STs. RPT [2 DC in next ST, DC in next 6 STs] around. SLST to top of CH-3.

RND 6: (shell edging): CH 3. 4 DC in same space. Skip 4 STs. RPT [5 DC in next ST. Skip 4 STs] around. SLST to top of CH-3.

Fasten off and weave in ends. Sew button on. Insert towel through hidden ring.
