



## Flower for a Hat (Crochet)

with YouTube Help Video

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Here is a flower that works great for a hat or headband. It is a layered flower that takes very little yarn to make. The leaves are also very simple to crochet. Check out the how-to video on the Naztazia YouTube channel here:

### Terminology:

CH = Chain

HDC = Half Double Crochet

RPT = Repeat

SLST = Slip Stitch

ST= Stitch

### Size/Gauge:

Flower diameter is 3.5". With leaves is 6" W x 3.5" H. Gauge not important.

### Materials:

Less than 20 yards total for flower and leaves. Sample used scrap yarn of Red Heart Super Saver 100% acrylic yarn in colors of yellow, off white, light pink, medium pink, and green. Crochet hook Size G (4 or 4.25 mm). Scissors. Yarn needle. Half-inch button.

### Instructions:

**Flower:** With yellow yarn, CH 4. SLST to close ring.

**RND 1:** CH 1. RPT [SC in ring, CH 3] 6 times. SLST to SC. Total = 6 spaces.

**RND 2:** CH 1. RPT [SC on top of SC, CH 4] 6 times. SLST to SC. Total = 6 spaces.

**RND 3:** CH 1. RPT [SC on top of SC, CH 5] 6 times. SLST to SC. Total = 6 spaces. Fasten off yarn, weave in ends.

Work from the outer layer spaces, inwards:

**RND 3 petals:** With medium pink yarn, place a slipknot on hook. RPT [SLST to next CH-5 space, CH 2, 4 DC, CH 2, SLST in same space] in each CH-5 space. Total = 6 petals. Fasten off.

**RND 2 petals:** With light pink yarn, place a slipknot on hook. RPT [SLST to next CH-4 space, CH 2, 3 DC, CH 2, SLST in same space] in each CH-4 space. Total = 6 petals. Fasten off.

**RND 1 petals:** With off-white yarn, place a slipknot on hook. RPT [SLST to next CH-3 space, CH 2, 2 DC, CH 2, SLST in same space] in each CH-3 space. Total = 6 petals. Fasten off.

**Leaves (make 2):** With green yarn, CH 11.

RND 1a: Skip 1<sup>st</sup> CH. In next CH, SC. In next, HDC. Make 6 DC over the next 6 CHs. In last 2 CHs, HDC, then SC. Pivot to work on other side of starting CH.

RND 1b: In same space as SC, SC. In same space as HDC, HDC. 6 DC over 6 DC, HDC over HDC, and SC in last space. Make a surface crochet chain along center. Fasten off, weave in ends.

### Combine pieces

Sew pieces together, cut and weave in all ends. TIP: use the half-inch button to first sew the flower and leaves together, then sew through the hat.
