



Crossed Treble Stitch (Crochet)

with YouTube Help Video

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The crossed treble stitch is one of my favorite crochet stitch patterns for when I need a lacy effect. This works great for a scarf, shawl, skirt, tunic, and more. It even works nice for curtains and a lightweight blanket! Terminology:

CH = Chain	DC = Double Crochet	RPT = Repeat
SK = Skip/Miss	SLST = Slip Stitch	ST= Stitch
TR = Treble Crochet	YO = Yarn Over

CH 41 (mult 4+1)

ROW 1: YO twice, insert hook into 5th CH from hook. RPT [work off 2 loops, YO, SK 2 CHs, place hook in next CH, and work off loops in group of 2. CH 2. DC in center. YO twice, insert hook into next CH] across until all cross stitches are made. In last CH, TR. CH 4, turn.

ROW 2: Work a cross TR on top of each cross TR from the previous row.

Continue repeating ROW 2 for the desired height.
