



## Crochet Cables (Crochet)

with YouTube Help Video

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Crochet cables add a wonderful texture to any piece. They almost look like crochet braids or a crochet rope. The cables in this sample are accomplished with front post crochet stitches. ### Terminology:

CH = Chain	DC = Double Crochet	RPT = Repeat
SC = Single Crochet	SLST = Slip Stitch	ST = Stitch
FPDC = Front Post Double Crochet	FPTR = Front Post Treble Crochet	

### Instructions:

CH 31 (mult 5+1). Note: CH-3s count as 1 DC.

**ROW 1:** DC in 4<sup>th</sup> CH from hook. DC across. Total = 29. CH 1, turn.

**ROW 2:** SC in each ST across. Total = 29. CH 3, turn.

**ROW 3:** RPT [DC in next 2 STs, skip 1, FPDC around next ST from 2 rows below, FPDC around next ST from 2 rows below, FPTR around skipped ST from 2 rows below. Skip the 3 STs from behind the FP-STs] across, ending with 1 DC in last 3 STs. CH 1, turn.

**ROW 4:** SC in each ST across. Total= 29. CH 3, turn.

**ROW 5:** RPT [DC in next 2 STs, skip 1, FPDC around middle FP-ST from below, FPDC around next FP-ST from below, FPTR around skipped FP-ST from below. Skip the 3 STs from behind the FP-STs] across, ending with 1 DC in last 3 STs. CH 1, turn.

**RPT ROWs 4 & 5 for desired height.** Fasten off, weave in ends.
