



Toilet Paper Hat Cover (Crochet)

with YouTube Help Video

A crochet toilet paper hat cover is a great way to hide your toilet paper! It seems toilet paper has become quite valuable these days. Terminology:

CH = Chain

DC = Half Double Crochet

RPT = Repeat

SLST = Slip Stitch

ST= Stitch

Size/Gauge:

Fits toilet paper 5" diameter by 4" height. Gauge 12 STs & 7 ROWs = 4"SQ.

Materials:

100 yards of worsted weight yarn. Sample used Red Heart Super Saver in Petal Pink and Perfect Pink. Crochet hook Size H (5 mm). Scissors. Yarn needle. 1.5 inch button (optional)

Instructions:

With light pink yarn, CH 4. SLST to form ring. CH 2 (not a ST). Work in spiral rounds and mark the first stitch of each round.

RND 1: 12 DC in ring. = 12 STs.

RND 2: 2 DC around = 24 STs.

RND 3: RPT [2 DC, 1 DC] around = 36 STs.

RND 4: RPT [2 DC, 1 DC, 1 DC] around = 48 STs.

At this point the circle should fit the top of the toilet paper. If not, start over and use a larger hook to make it larger or a smaller hook to make a smaller circle.

RNDs 5-8: 1 DC around. After the 8th round, end with a SLST in the next ST and change color to medium pink yarn.

Try the hat onto the toilet paper. You should need to make about 2 more rounds. If it's too short, add another double crochet round. If it's too long, rip out a round.

RNDs 9 & 10: CH 3. 1 DC around. SLST to CH-3. Change color to light pink yarn.

RND 11: CH 3. 2 DC around. SLST to CH-3.

RND 12: CH 3. 1 DC around. SLST to CH-3.

Fasten off and weave in ends. Sew on decorative button in the front if desired.
