



Shell and Popcorn Stitch (Crochet)

with YouTube Help Video

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It is fun to crochet and combine a shell and popcorn stitch into one pattern. The texture is amazing, plus the two stitches create an amazing design. This works great for a blanket, scarf, shawl, bag, and more. Terminology:

CH = Chain

DC = Double Crochet

RPT = Repeat

SC = Single Crochet

SK = Skip/Miss

ST= Stitch

POP = Popcorn Stitch. Make 5 DC in ST. Remove hook from loop. Insert hook in first DC (front to back) and in removed loop. Draw loop through. CH 1.

SHELL = 5 DC in ST.

CH 32, or multiple of 6 + 2

ROW 1: SC in 2nd CH from hook and in each CH across. CH 3, turn.

ROW 2: RPT [SK 2 ST, SHELL, SK 2 ST, POP] across, ending with a SHELL, SK 2, DC in last ST. CH 3, turn.

ROW 3: RPT [SC in 3rd DC, CH 2, SC on top of POP, CH 2] across, ending with DC on top of turning CH. CH 3, turn.

ROW 4: RPT ROW 2, ending with DC on top of turning CH. CH 3, turn.

ROW 5: RPT ROW 3.

Continue repeating ROWs 4 & 5, ending on a ROW 4.
