Pinwheel Kitchen Pad and Scrubber Set (Crochet)

Here is a cute pinwheel kitchen pad and scrubber set. You can use the pad as a hot pad or pot holder and the smaller one as a dish scrubber. They are both made with Tunisian crochet; however, you do not need any special hook. A regular crochet hook works for both patterns. Terminology:

CH = Chain ST = Stitch TSS = Tunisian Simple Stitch

Size/Gauge:

Scrubber = 5". Pad = 8.5" without loop. Gauge = 18 STs x 16 ROWs = 4"SQ.

Materials:

For the scrubber, 50 yards of worsted weight cotton yarn in 6 colors. Sample used Sugar n Cream yarn. Pad uses 130 yards. Regular crochet hook Size F (3.75 mm). You can use a Tunisian hook if you wish. Scissors. Yarn needle.

Instructions:

Scrubber (Make 2).

TSS = Tunisian Simple Stitch

With Color A, CH 10.

ROW 1: 1 loop on hook.

ROW 2: Work 1 TSS into next CH. (2 loops). Return.

ROW 3: Work 1 TSS into next ST and 1 TSS into next CH. (3 loops). Return.

ROW 4: Work 1 TSS into next 2 STs and 1 TSS into next CH. (4 loops). Return.

Continue working in this pattern for all 10 loops. Take note of where the 10th loop is entered into the CH. Refer to this as the "base chain." All subsequent 10th loops from the other 5 colors will go into this base chain. On the return pass, change to Color B by drawing it through the last 2 loops.

With Color B, repeat these 10 ROWs, using TSS bars instead of the CHs. As mentioned above, on the 10th loop for ROW 10, insert hook into the base chain.

Continue working the 10 ROWs with Color C, D, E, and F. Once completed, use yarn and yarn needle to sew seam. Place both scrubbers, wrong side together, and either sew or single crochet pieces together along the edge. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Kitchen Pad (Make 2).

With Color A, CH 18.

Repeat pattern for Scrubber, except work the pattern for 18 loops. Repeat Colors B, C, D, E, and F for 18 ROWs. If crocheting 2 pieces together, CH 14 for the hanging
