CH 30 for a sample (multiple of 8+6)

ROW 1: DC in 5th CH. DC in next CH. RPT [SKIP 2 CHs, 1 DC in next CH, CH 3, 3 DC around DC, SKIP 2 CHs, 1 DC in next 3 CHs] across. CH 3, turn.

ROW 2: 1 DC in next 2 STs. RPT [CH 2, 1 SC on top of tilted square, CH 2, 1 DC in next 3 STs] across. CH 3, turn.

ROW 3: 1 DC in next 2 STs. RPT [SKIP 2 CHs, 1 DC on top of SC, CH 3, 3 DC around DC, SKIP 2 CHs, 1 DC in next 3 STs] across. CH 3, turn.

ROW 4: Same as ROW 2.

RPT ROWs 3 & 4 until desired height.
