



## Tilted Square Stitch (Crochet)

The tilted square stitch is comprised of double crochet that form a slanted square in between a set of stitches. If you are looking for something a little different than plain double crochet, this stitch creates a neat effect! ### Terminology:

CH = Chain

DC = Double Crochet

RPT = Repeat

SC = Single Crochet

SLST = Slip Stitch

ST= Stitch

### Instructions:

Watch the YouTube tutorial video here: <https://youtube.com/naztazia> Look for "Tilted Square Stitch."

CH 30 for a sample (multiple of 8+6)

ROW 1: DC in 5<sup>th</sup> CH. DC in next CH. RPT [SKIP 2 CHs, 1 DC in next CH, CH 3, 3 DC around DC, SKIP 2 CHs, 1 DC in next 3 CHs] across. CH 3, turn.

ROW 2: 1 DC in next 2 STs. RPT [CH 2, 1 SC on top of tilted square, CH 2, 1 DC in next 3 STs] across. CH 3, turn.

ROW 3: 1 DC in next 2 STs. RPT [SKIP 2 CHs, 1 DC on top of SC, CH 3, 3 DC around DC, SKIP 2 CHs, 1 DC in next 3 STs] across. CH 3, turn.

ROW 4: Same as ROW 2.

RPT ROWs 3 & 4 until desired height.
