

Here is a fun border or edging for your blankets and other items. I call it the flame stitch because each motif is shaped like a flame. Stitch multiple of $4+3$.
BEGIN: SC in first ST on the row.

FLAME: CH 1, Skip 1 ST, SC in next 3 STs. CH 2. Remove hook from loop. Insert hook in SP before 3 SCs and draw through loop. CH 1. In ring, SC, HDC, DC, TR. CH 2, SLST to top of TR just made (picot). TR, DC, HDC, SC.

Repeat FLAME across row. At the end, CH 1, Skip 1 ST, SC in last ST.

## CORNERS:

If turning the corner, make 2 more SCs in last ST for the corner. CH 2, remove hook from loop, and continue from, "Insert hook in SP before 3 SCs..." from FLAME instructions above. Proceed along next side as in first FLAME side.
