The crochet cabbage patch stitch pattern is a lovely vintage stitch that works nicely for a blanket, scarf, shawl, and more. The look is formed by making double crochet stitches on one row followed by crossed double crochet stitches on the next row. Check out the how-to video on the Naztazia YouTube channel here:

Terminology:

CH = Chain

DC = Double Crochet

RPT = Repeat

Instructions:

CH 35 (multiple of 4+3)

ROW 1: Skip 4 CHs, make 4 DC in next CH. RPT [Skip 3 CHs, make 4 DC in next CH] across, until last 2 CHs. Skip 1 CH, 1 DC in last CH. CH 3, turn.

ROW 2: Make 1 DC in 4th DC of previous 4-DC. CH 2. Cross over and make 1 DC in 1st DC of same 4-DC, encasing the DC just made. RPT [DC in 4th DC of next 4-DC, CH 2, cross over, make 1 DC in 1st DC of same 4-DC] across. Make 1 DC in turning CH. CH 3, turn.

ROW 3: Make 4 DC in each CH-2 space across. Make 1 DC in turning CH. CH 3, turn.

ROWS 4+: RPT ROWS 2 & 3 for pattern.
