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Rose (Crochet)

with YouTube Help Video

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The crochet rose is a nice simple flower pattern that uses single crochet and double crochet stitches along with the starting chain. This works great as an embellishment to a hat, scarf, shawl, blanket, bag and more. Terminology:		
CH = Chain	DC = Double Crochet	RPT = Repeat
SC = Single Crochet	ST = Stitch	

Instructions:

This sample rose uses worsted weight yarn and a size G 4 mm or 4.25 mm crochet hook.

Leave a few inches starting tail end for tying/knotting and CH 31.

ROW 1: Skip the first CH, and SC in each ST across. CH 1, turn. (30 SC)

ROW 2: SC in first ST. In next ST, 5 DC. SC in next ST. RPT [SC in next ST, 5 DC in next ST, 5 DC in next ST, SC in next ST] across.

Fasten off, leaving a 12" tail end of sewing

Roll the flower from one end towards its other end following its beginning chain line. Using the ending tail end and a yarn needle, turn flower over and take a few stitches through all rolls in the back to secure the flower's shape.

At this point you could fasten off or use the beginning and ending tail end to tie or sew the flower onto an item such as a hat, scarf, shawl, bag, blanket, and more.
