
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## Heart Wave Stitch (Crochet)

The crochet heart wave stitch pattern creates a nice look for an afghan or blanket. Shell stitches form the wave of hearts. It is an easy pattern to remember and looks nice in one color or with multiple colors. CH 32 or any multiple of 6+2.

ROW 1: Skip the 1<sup>st</sup> CH, and SC in next CH. RPT [Skip 2 CHs, 6 DC in next CH. Skip 2 CHs, SC in next CH] across. CH 3, turn.

ROW 2: 3-DC CL over first 3 STs. RPT [CH 7. 6 DC CL over next 6 DC STs, skipping over the previous row's SC] across, ending with 4-DC CL over 3 DC STs and top of turning CH. CH 3, turn.

ROW 3: RPT [6 DC in 4<sup>th</sup> CH of each CH-7] across, ending with 1 DC in turning CH. CH 3, turn.

ROW 4: 3-DC CL over first 3 STs. RPT [CH 7. 6 DC CL over next 6 DC STs] across, ending with 4-DC CL over last 3 DC STs and top of turning CH. CH 3, turn.

RPT ROWs 3 & 4 for desired size.
