



Double Shell Border (Crochet)

with YouTube Help Video

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The double shell border is a neat slanted stitch pattern that works nicely as an edging or a border. I have used it around a blanket, shawl, scarf, and other items. Terminology:

CH = Chain

DC = Double Crochet

RPT = Repeat

SC = Single Crochet

SLST = Slip Stitch

ST= Stitch

Instructions:

Watch the YouTube tutorial video here: <https://youtube.com/naztazia> Look for “Double Shell Border.”

Stitch multiple of 6 + 1

ROW 1: CH 3 (counts as first DC). RPT [CH 2. Skip 2 STs, DC in next ST] across. If working in the round, end with a CH 2 and SLST to CH-3.

ROW 2: Join new color on top of ROW 1’s CH 3 and SC in same ST. RPT [DC in next DC. CH 3. Make 6 DC over DC just made. SC in next DC] across or around. CH 1, turn.

ROW 3: SC in same space. RPT [CH 5. SC in next SC.] across. If working in the round, end with a SLST to the first ST. Turn work.

ROW 4: Join new color if desired. CH 3. SC in the 3rd CH of previous CH-5 to stagger the shells. RPT [DC in next SC. CH 3. Make 6 DC over DC just made. SC in the 3rd CH of previous CH-5] across or around.

Fasten off and weave in ends.
