Terminol	ogy:

CH = Chain	HDC = Half Double Crochet	RPT = Repeat
SLST = Slip Stitch	ST= Stitch	

Size/Gauge:

3 inch in diameter. Gauge is not necessarily important

Materials:

Less than 10 yards of worsted weight yarn in yellow and pink or other colors. Crochet hook Size G (4 or 4.25 mm) and D (3.25 mm) or another hook size. Piece of office tape. Scissors. Yarn needle. Button (optional).

Instructions:

With yellow, slipknot. CH 4. SLST to close ring.

RND 1: CH 1 (does not count as a ST). 10 HDC in ring. SLST or Fasten off and close ring with yarn and needle.

With pink, place a slipknot on hook. SLST in any ST.

RND 2: RPT [CH 4, SK 1, SLST in next ST] around. Total = 5 loops created.

RND 3: RPT in each loop [SLST in loop, CH 3, 5-wrap bullion, CH 1, 7-wrap bullion, CH 1, 5-wrap bullion, CH 3. SLST in loop].

Fasten off, weave in ends. Sew or glue on button in the center if desired.
