

RND 4: SC around. (18 STs).
RND 5: RPT (2 SC, SC, SC, SC, SC, SC) around. (21 STs).

For the first one, fasten off, leaving a $10^{\prime \prime}$ tail end for sewing. After the second one, continue onto RND 6 with the working yarn.

RND 6: Holding the second piece in the dominant hand, and the first piece in the non-dominant hand, make 1 SC into the ST after the fasten-off ST. Continue with making 16 more SC (total = 17 SC). 4 SC should remain. Leave those unworked. Skip 4 SC on the second piece and continue with making 17 SC on this piece. ( 34 STs ). RND 7: RPT (8 SC, SC2TOG, 7 SC) on both pieces. (32 STs). RND 8: RPT (7 SC, SC2TOG, 7 SC ) on both pieces. ( 30 STs ). RND 9: RPT (7 SC, SC2TOG, 6 SC) on both pieces. ( 28 STs).

At this time, sew the two pieces together (the 4 skipped STs on both).
RND 10: RPT ( $6 \mathrm{SC}, \mathrm{SC} 2 T O G, 6 \mathrm{SC}$ ) on both pieces. ( 26 STs ).
RND 11: RPT (6 SC, SC2TOG, 5 SC) on both pieces. ( 24 STs ).
RND 12: RPT ( $5 \mathrm{SC}, \mathrm{SC} 2 \mathrm{TOG}, 5 \mathrm{SC}$ ) on both pieces. ( 22 STs ).
RND 13: RPT (5 SC, SC2TOG, 4 SC) on both pieces. ( 20 STs ).

At this time, add some stuffing to the heart.
RND 14: RPT (4 SC, SC2TOG, 4 SC) on both pieces. (18 STs).
RND 15: RPT (4 SC, SC2TOG, 3 SC) on both pieces. (16 STs).
RND 16: RPT (3 SC, SC2TOG, 3 SC) on both pieces. (14 STs).
RND 17: RPT (3 SC, SC2TOG, 2 SC) on both pieces. (12 STs).
Add more stuffing and cinch and sew bottom closed. Fasten off and weave in all ends.
