



Birthday Cake Toilet Paper Cover (Crochet)

with YouTube Help Video

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A birthday cake is a cute gift for someone on his or her birthday. It also can serve as a toilet paper cover. This cake is quick to make and is sure to bring about a smile! Terminology:

CH = Chain	DC = Double Crochet	HDC = Half Double Crochet
RPT = Repeat	SC = Single Crochet	SLST = Slip Stitch
ST= Stitch		

Size/Gauge:

5.5" W x 9" H. Fits a 4.75" diameter roll of toilet paper. Gauge = 15 STs & 11 ROWS = 4" SQ in HDC.

Materials:

100 yards worsted weight yarn. Sample used Mainstays 100% acrylic. Crochet hook Size G (4 or 4.25 mm). Scissors. Yarn needle. Polyester Fiberfil stuffing.

CAKE

Make a magic ring. CH 1. In the cake section, CH-1s do not count as a ST. Change colors as desired. In sample, color changed every RND.

RND 1: 12 HDC in ring. Pull to close. SLST to first ST. Total = 12.

RND 2: 2 HDC in each ST around. SLST to first ST. Total = 24.

RND 3: RPT [2 HDC, 1 HDC in next ST] around. SLST to first ST. Total = 36.
RND 4: RPT [2 HDC, 1 HDC in next 2 STs] around. SLST to first ST. Total = 48.
RND 5: RPT [2 HDC, 1 HDC in next 3 STs] around. SLST to first ST. Total = 60.
RND 6: 1 HDC in the back loops only just for this RND. SLST to first ST. Total = 60.
RNDs 7-16: 1 HDC around. SLST to first ST. Total = 60.
Fasten off and weave in ends.

ICING

First bobble: Make a slipknot on hook. SLST to any front loop from RNDs 5-6. * CH 3.
Make 4 DC in same loop. Remove hook and insert from front-to-back into top of CH-3.
Pull yarn through. CH 1. Skip 2 STs. SLST in next ST. *

All other bobbles: RPT from * to * from First bobble.

RPT “First bobble” and “All other bobbles” along the bottom of RND 16 in either the front or back loops (depending upon how you hold the cake). Fasten off and weave in ends.

CANDLE

Make a magic ring. CH 1. For a thinner candle, make 6 SC in ring. Pull to close ring. Work in spirals, making one SC in the back loops only for about 2.5” (or as desired). For a thicker candle, make 8 SC in ring instead. Fasten off, leaving a longer tail end for sewing to CAKE. Stuff a bit with yarn or polyester fiberfill if desired.

FLAME

Side 1: CH 9. Skip 3 CHs and DC in 4th CH from hook. Make 1 HDC in next 2 CHs. Make 1 SC in next 2 CHs. SLST in last CH. Pivot to work on other side of CH.

Side 2: SC in next 2 STs 1 HDC in next 2 STs. 1 DC in next 2 STs. Along bottom edge, make 3 SC evenly across. SLST to finish. Fasten off, leaving a longer tail end for sewing the CANDLE.

Sew FLAME to CANDLE. Sew CANDLE to CAKE. Weave in all ends. Place over toilet paper to form shape.
