



# Reversible Crochet (Crochet)

with YouTube Help Video

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Reversible Crochet Stitch is a neat textured pattern created by crocheting two pieces separately for two rows, then joining them together. ## Terminology:

CH = Chain	DC = Double Crochet	RPT = Repeat
SC = Single Crochet	SK = Skip	SLST = Slip Stitch
ST= Stitch	TR = Treble Crochet	V-ST = 2 DC, CH 1, 2 DC

## Instructions:

CH 27 (multiple of 5+2)

ROW 1: With COLOR A, SC in 2nd CH from hook. RPT [CH 5, SK 4 CHs, SC in 5th CH] across. At the end, remove hook and either leave a long loop or place a paper clip in the loop to keep from becoming undone.

ROW 2: With COLOR B, attach with a SLST to beginning SC of ROW 1. CH 4. V-ST In the 3rd CH of each CH-5 SP. End with a TR in last ST. Turn work.

ROW 3: Insert hook back into COLOR A, CH 4. Fold ROW 1 to meet ROW 2. Work V-ST in each CH-5 SP of ROW 1 and CH-1 SP of ROW 2 simultaneously. End with a TR in last ST of COLOR A. Turn work.

ROW 4: WITH COLOR B, CH 1, SC in same ST. RPT [CH 5, SC in between V-STs from previous same COLOR ROW] across. End with a SC on top of CH-4. Turn work.

ROW 5: WITH COLOR B, CH 4. Work V-ST in each CH-5 SP of previous ROW and CH-1 SP of other color. End with TR in last ST. Turn work.

ROW 6: With COLOR A, CH 1. SC in same ST. RPT [CH 5, SC in between V-STs from previous same COLOR ROW] across. End with a SC on top of CH-4. Turn work.

ROW 7: With COLOR A, CH 4. Work V-ST in each CH-5 SP of previous ROW and CH-1 SP of other color. End with TR in last ST. Turn work.

RPT ROWs 4-7 until desired height, ending with a ROW 5.

LAST ROW: CH 1. SC in same ST. RPT [CH 2, SLST to center of CH-1 SP, CH 2, SC in between V-STs] across. End with SC in last ST. Fasten off and weave in ends.
